

# Intimate Partner Violence

Myth: Domestic violence only happens in heterosexual relationships between cisgender partners

Fact: About half of lesbian and bisexual women report having experienced physical violence in an intimate relationship

Fact: Up to 45% of gay and bisexual men report having experienced physical violence from a romantic partner

Fact: 89% of trans respondents reported experiencing IPV, with 59% reporting having experienced physical violence
